

COMPOSITION TIPS

Composition is the arrangement of elements in an image. It is key to give priority to an element and be able to convey a clear message.



1. DEFINE THE OBJECTIVE WHAT DO YOU WANT TO CAPTURE?








Open your mind

If you are walking down the street, there will surely be many details that go unnoticed in the scene. For them, you will need to open your eyes and connect with the environment. Start distinguishing colors, textures and possible scenarios or causal actors for your photo.


COMPOSITION TIPS THE RULE OF THIRDS



Using the rule of thirds draws the viewer's eye into the composition, instead of just glancing at the center. By placing the subject off center, you also embrace more blank space. The rule of thirds is also helpful for highlighting an interesting background.

The purple dots mark areas where we pay more attention, "points of interest".

That's why we recommend putting elements in one of these spaces to ensure your photo is memorable.








PRE-PHOTO PREPARATION

- Clean your camera lens before you start
- Check if you have enough battery before taking a photo.
- Avoid using zoom, because it decreases the photo quality





LIGHTING TIPS

NATURAL LIGHT



Use natural light whenever possible, as it softens the light and marks shadows.

The ideal schedule is from 12 - 15hrs

CONTRASTS



Ensure that the lights don't look burnt (too white) and the shadows too dark so that the details don't get lost.







TIPS FOR WHEN TAKING THE PHOTO


También, se aconseja realizar varias tomas para así elegir la mejor.

EDITING TOOLS

a. Automatic

Open your phone's photo roll, select "edit" and press "automatic". The phone's software itself will make the adjustments it deems necessary to perfect your image.

b. Manual

On the same reel, instead of pressing the "automatic" button, we will immerse ourselves in exploring function by function. There we can raise or lower the colors, their intensities, add textures, focus objects and highlight everything we want

c. Application

There are many applications to edit images. The most recommended on IOS and Android are:

- PicsArt
- InShot
- Snapseed
- Unfold
- VSCO



In these Apps, in addition to achieving all the changes offered by the phone editor, it will allow you to add different effects, frames and definitions. Each app is unique!

Many times what makes us choose between one and the other are not its effects or edits, but its interface (how friendly it is), so explore all the possibilities of each application.
