It is precisely in this complex time that we make sure that we continue to strengthen all our actions and create strong connections between Israel and the Diaspora. In recent times, parallel to our regular activities, we have done volunteer work, taken care of soldiers who were part of Hanoar Hatzioni and today risk their lives for Israel, helped a lot in the process of restoring Kibbutz Ein Hasholsha, which we are very fond of, and we have done many other initiatives. I invite you to read this booklet and get a sense of the variety of significant activities we have carried out around the world in the last six months, which demonstrate our commitment to Zionism in these days.

We remain committed to fostering the connection between Israel and the Diaspora, and to continuing to be a pioneering movement in all areas of our activity. In the midst of such a challenging period, we look forward to the year 2024, full of hope and filled with pride for the country and the People we love so much.


ARGENTINA

EIN HASHLOSHA

Since the beginning of the war, we made two visits to the community of Ein Hashlosha, which was evacuated to Eilat. The first visit was made by Dani and Lore, rakazot of Shnat together with representatives of the Kvutza Shnat Tzafon. This visit coincided with the 73rd anniversary of the Kibbutz, so our chaverim joined the Kabalat Shabbat celebration and had a meaningful meeting with the vatikim and vatikot of the Kibbutz. They also took the opportunity to share a peula with the youth of the Kibbutz and to play board games with the adults.













The second visit was made by Alex, General Director of the Tnua, and Romi, Coordinator of the Education Department, who had a talk with the Kibbutz Board of Directors, to discuss future plans of action and to remind again that the Tnua Hanoar Hatzioni is fully at their disposal.

In addition to this, chaverim and relatives of our tnua in Belgium held a family Shabbat to raise funds for this beloved kibbutz.



ONCE A CHAVER, ALWAYS CHAVER FOR DANIEL LEVI Z"L.

They say that you can count your friends on the fingers of one hand. We thought so until we had the privilege of getting to know Daniel Levi z "I's story a little more closely.

Daniel, nicknamed by his acquaintances and friends as "el loco", was born in Lima, Peru, 34 years ago. He grew up there, attended León Pinelo school and attended Thua activities since he was a child. His bond with Hanoar Hatzioni grew as he grew up too. He was an excellent madrich, to the point of having created deep and meaningful bonds with his chanichim to this day. After finishing his cycle in the Tnua, and already after starting his medical studies, Daniel accompanied several Thua groups in their local machanot and continental machonim as a paramedic. Finally, after finishing his degree, he decided to make aliyah and start a new chapter of his life in Israel. Here he joined the army, met his wife Lihi and had two beautiful children. During the last time, Daniel's family decided to live in Kibbutz Beeri, given the proximity of the Kibbutz to Beer Sheva, a city to which Daniel traveled to work in Soroka hospital as a doctor.

On Saturday, October 7, 2023, Daniel was about to leave for an on-call at the hospital when the sirens began to sound announcing that it was time to enter the shelter. After a couple of hours, Daniel received a call from the kibbutz nurse asking him to come urgently to the kibbutz medical ward as there were three wounded in need of medical assistance, two of them in serious condition. Daniel, without hesitation, went out to help and managed to save the lives of those people who were in critical condition. Unfortunately, however, he did not survive the attack by Hamas terrorists. A few days passed before his death was confirmed. His family arrived in Israel, together with friends and acquaintances, to say their last goodbye to Daniel.

Since then, we have heard a lot about him. In his Shiva, on television, in the media writing and telling his story of heroism. However, none of that compares to the day we met him through the eyes of his wife, his mother and brother.

As part of a Tnua project that aims to preserve Daniel's memory and share his story in all the kenim where Hanoar Hatzioni is active, we decided to make a documentary about his life and legacy.

For hours we listened with attention, affection and much emotion to the description of such a noble person. We listened to Daniel's story through the eyes of Mirella, his mother, and got to know Daniel as a son. A respectful, loving son, caring for his mother and eager to show his love for her in small and big details. We heard of a responsible, caring and big-hearted son.

In Mirella's story, there was a central point that did not go unnoticed: Daniel's friends and Daniel as a friend. Daniel as a given child, a friend, a being who makes everyone who is close to him feel good and at ease. Daniel's name is so closely associated with the concept of friendship that his friends of his generation made a formal request to the Pinelo school to name the best classmate award after him. The request was accepted and this was the first cycle that participated in such a beautiful initiative.

Then we listened to his brother, Jimmy. We felt the nostalgia, the deep longing and the giant affection that existed between them. We heard the story of a fun-loving, sociable Daniel who was able to make friends with people younger than him, people his own age, older people and even his friends' parents. We heard about a Daniel who leaves deep impressions wherever he is and who manages to organize spontaneous reunions, even walking from one side of the city to the other. Jimmy told us about a being full of good energies capable of motivating whoever is next to him to want to be and do more and better. We heard about a Daniel who does not wait for others to change, but changes himself to improve and facilitate things in his environment. This is how he decided to learn to speak Russian, in order to simplify communication and create a friendlier environment with some of the nurses who still do not speak Hebrew or English well.

And finally, we heard from Lihi, his wife and mother of his children. And there we heard the story of a true "gentleman", a loving, respectful man, connected to his family, attentive to their welfare in every possible way. Lihi told us about a studious person, curious and eager to learn and improve himself, while at the same time building and strengthening the foundations of his family together with his partner. We listened to Lihi talk about the love of his life. A giant, pure and deep love. We listened to his wife, speak proudly of her husband, of all that he was and all that he could have been. She described the loss of Daniel as "a loss for humanity". After listening to the testimonies of some of his family, we are sure that Lihi is right.

Before we left, Lihi told us that Daniel managed to save two lives on 7.10 as a doctor, but that long before that, he managed to save the life of another person, as a civilian, through bone marrow donation. The person who received his donation was to meet Daniel two weeks after that terrible Saturday when Daniel lost his life. The meeting between Daniel and the man who now lives because of him was not possible. His family attended instead, amidst a myriad of mixed emotions.

Daniel is physically no longer with us. The loss of this human being is terrible. But all that Daniel was, is and represents is still present. There is no value in the DNA of our Tnua in which Daniel was not exemplary. He was an excellent son, an excellent brother, an excellent colleague, an excellent husband, an excellent father, an excellent human being. And with all and all, Daniel you were, are and will be an excellent chaver, with all that word means in its different meanings.

You are the faithful portrait of what we call "Magshim" and your personal example will be an educational compass for all those who know your story. Of course we will remember your last minutes, as a heroic display of your love for life, your love for each other, your desire to help beyond measure, but we want you to know that your 34 years and all that you have done during them, will make it even more so.

Most people probably have as many friends as fingers on their hand, but we know that you have countless friends who love you, miss you and will continue your legacy. Thank you for all that you taught us, for all that you passed on, while you were alive and afterwards as well.

MICHAEL ROSENTAL

He has also uploaded content to social networks and given talks to the community, especially on responsible management of social networks and prevention.



AMIR GRUNHAUS

Boguer of Hanoar Hatzioni B'Costa Rica.Amir was President of Tikvah: The Zionist Voice on Campus at UC Berkeley, California - a student organization to combat Anti-Zionism and Anti-Semitism. In addition, he was a fellow of StandWithUs, the Helen Diller Institute, and CAMERA, where he was named in the top 12 student activists.

He is currently an educator and activist. He is dedicated to combating misinformation about Israel and Anti-Semitism. He recently opened an Instagram page, <u>@amirg_isr</u>, with the goal of educating others about Israel, and promoting accurate information about the conflict. So far, his page has reached over 750,000 accounts and 1.5 million impressions.



AARON POLICAR

He is the General Director of Manhigut Mexico and a member of the Board of Directors of FeMeJJJ (Mexican Federation of Jewish Youth), currently works as a teacher of Jewish education in one of the schools of the Jewish network in Mexico and is the Director of the Alia Department of the Jewish Agency for Israel in the North Latin America region.

Aaron has been trained for over 10 years as an expert on topics such as History of Zionism, Israeli Society, Israeli-Palestinian Conflict and others. He has participated in various conferences such as

StandWithUs, AJC Global Forum, WUJS, among others. @thenewherzl

As a result of the current war in Israel, he has given multiple lectures, prepared courses for young university students, participated in panels, coordinating and centralizing activities of solidarity, support and hasbara for the Jewish Community of Mexico. Also, he recorded two podcast chapters talking about the conflict and the great wave of anti-Semitism that has impacted all Jewish communities around the world, having more than 100K views on instagram and more than 1000 views on YouTube.

NISAN CIALIC INTERVIEW



Our chaver Nisan Cialic participated in an interview with the media "enlacejudío.com" where he talked about his participation in the Mossad and his activism in South America, where he chased Josef Mengele in South America. In an exclusive interview, he tells us the story.

In 1941, the war doctor Josef Mengele received the Iron Cross Second Class for his actions at the front in the Ukraine. A year later, the member of the SS would obtain the decoration in First Class after saving two German soldiers from a burning tank.

In the same year 1941, but 11,000 kilometers away, Nisan Cialic was born into an Ashkenazi Jewish family in Argentina. Already at the age of 17, the young Cialic showed a very active militancy in the Zionist cause, which led him to enroll in the Machon LeMadrijim, a training program for youth leaders in Israel.

Between the years 1942 and 1945, while Cialic was just a preschooler, Mengele was building his ultimate reputation: not as a war hero but as one of the greatest criminals mankind has ever known.

After his brief stint in the battlefields, Mengele asked to be transferred to the Auschwitz extermination camp, where he could indulge one of his great passions. A career physician, Mengele was obsessed with genetics and its stunted daughter, eugenics. In the name of this pseudo-science, born in Europe but promoted in the United States, the Nazi officer conceived and carried out all kinds of experiments, especially on twins.

Unlike other doctors, who found the work of selecting prisoners to be killed in the gas chambers and dividing them from those who would serve in the forced labor camps especially stressful, Mengele seemed to enjoy the task. He is remembered whistling happy tunes as he decided with one finger who should live and who would be killed.

He enjoyed this work because, among other things, it allowed him to identify the twins he would later use for his experiments. Thanks to them, Mengele could serve as the perfect representation of the "mad scientist". But not a good-natured and absent-minded one with crazy hair, but the central character of a horror movie.

The lives of both characters were about to cross in the early 1960s, when Cialic, then a young 18-year-old Zionist, serving as a Sheliach in a province 600 kilometers from Buenos Aires, received a phone call that would lead him to live a novel adventure.

"I was surprised that they called me (...) because the economic means that the youth movement had were not to be wasted on urgent travel," recalls Cialic from his home in Israel, in an exclusive conversation with Enlace Judío. Almost sixty years after those events, some names, some dates escape the memory of the current world president of Hanoar Hatzioní, and vice president of Keren Kayemet Lelsrael.

However, he reconstructs the generals of the story that he had to keep silent for decades, at the express instruction of the government that, without his knowledge at the time, recruited him to follow the trail of Josef Mengele, the "Angel of Death", in South America.

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
TZAV 8 TNUATI
