## DURING MIC4 IN ISRAEL

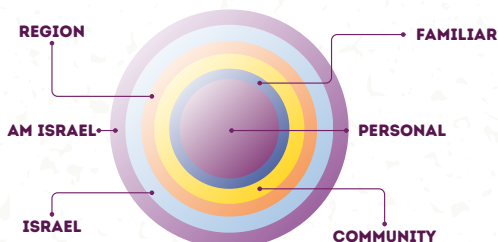


In this ceremony we remember one of the most difficult days for Medinat and Am Israel, the Hamas terror attack of October 7, 2023.

The date on which MIC 3 was held in Israel, a day that shook us and continues to change us to this day as the clashes continue.

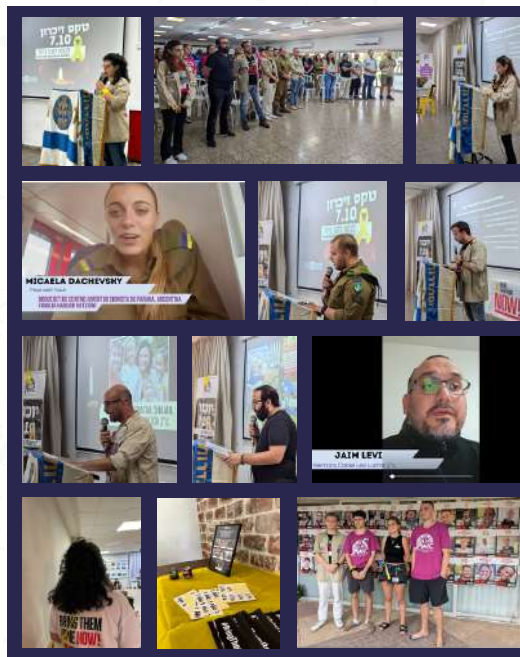

From the beginning of this terrible event, where young people were killed and kidnapped at the Nova Festival, followed by the kibbutzim that were invaded, destroyed and massacred, we remember and demand the release of all the innocent people who are still kidnapped today, as well as the thousands of lives that were lost, including chaverim and chaverot, families and soldiers.



At this event we had the presence of Olim and Olot, members of Mazkirut Olamit, participants of the MIC and other guests who accompanied us and joined together to remember, raise their voices and demand the return of all those who remain abducted, including Eitu and Iao.

We hope that better times will come and that the abducted people, soldiers and evacuated families will soon return home so that we can rebuild our society.

## Mexico

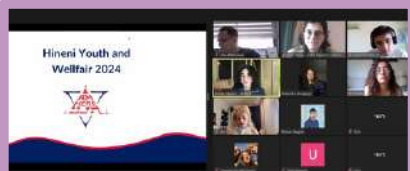
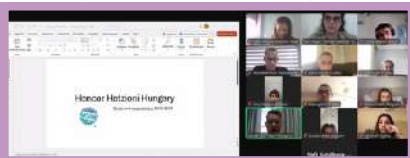
## Forum Ha'Atzama

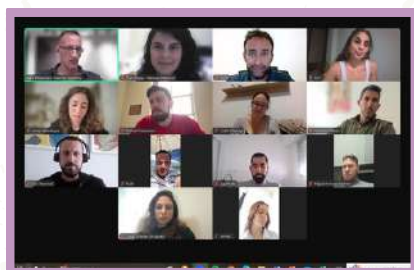
## Shlichim Meeting, Sao Paulo

# Shnat Hachshara



This year has certainly been one of challenges and resilience. Since 7/10 we have continued with our program, providing professional support and adapting the tochnit to ensure that the experience is educational, meaningful, and supports the development and training of the next leaders of our kenim and communities.



## Shnat Tzafon 23/24

Despite what happened on 7/10, the Shnat Tzafon 23/24 Kvutza, which was already in Israel, continued with the program. The kvutza showed great courage in choosing to remain in Israel and enormous commitment in seeking to contribute from their place in every way possible.

## Shnat Darom 2024

We welcome the Shnat Darom kvutza, formed by members of Hanoar Hatzioni Uruguay, Hanoar Hatzioni Paraguay, Tzeirei Ami Chile and Yajad Spain. That they performed their tochnit successfully and meaningfully despite the challenges.



## Shnat Jazit Hanoar Uruguay

For the first time, we were organizers of the Shnat Hachshara program of Jazit Hanoar Uruguay. In March, we received a kvutza of 23 participants willing to have an enriching experience, achieving a successful program.



## We continue to educate despite everything



While we were going through the Iron Swords war, these kvutzot made the decision to come to Israel to perform Shnat Hachshara. It was a year of many challenges that they were able to face and managed to complete their program in a successful and meaningful way after 8 months.

## Seminar Zman

For the first time, in August 2024, the Zman Seminar was held. A two-week seminar that brought together the kvutzot of **Shnat Tzafon, Shnat Darom and Shnat Jazit** to work in depth on the ideology of the tnuot and to foster continental interaction.



# Israel Challenge



Everything has been going uphill since the sudden interruption of "Israel Challenge Tzafon 2023" due to the tragedy of 7/10. In addition to everything that was happening at the national level, two new variables were added that only made the path even more complicated: **Uncertainty about the future and security of our Medina; and the tendency of young people to seek shorter tochniot outside of Israel.** The line we had to follow was clear: **go all out to open a new cycle.**

When the number of participants threatened to be no more than zero; when many had thrown in the towel; and when all seemed lost... What had to happen happened: **Hanoar Hatzioni once again demonstrated its community spirit and its enormous support network.** It gave us its unconditional support to move forward. And so, in a matter of days, was born....

**MADE IN MADRID:** A reversal of "Made in Israel" (the block developed in Tel Aviv) that aimed to make ourselves known as a decisive and cutting-edge organization; to give peace of mind to families; to invite our participants to continue adding experiences related to our history and people from another perspective; and finally (behind the scenes), to give us time as a country to calm the waters.

It was a huge effort, but it was worth it: **Made In Madrid was a success that transcended the entire MASA educational community.** Thanks to it, we managed to get more than 60 participants to land in Ben Gurion between September 4 and 5, and we gave a formal start to Israel Challenge here, where it should always have been.

After two weeks in Eilat, the program opened its **second new stage** that captivated and inspired the participants to stay:

**"Meirim et Israel"** – The premise: 10 days of volunteering, walks and talks about 7/10 so that they can feel part of Israeli society and contribute to its reconstruction. The activities and the tzevet managed to capture the interest and commitment of everyone, **resulting in another success that will remain in the memory of the event forever.**

Today, also with great emotion and pride, we have **more than half of the participants who continue the program at MARVA.** And I would not like you to stop at the simplicity of an exact number. **The nominal value means nothing compared to the relative value.** In a country at war and under known threats, the fact that so many families entrust us with their children to enter a stage in the IDF is no small thing. It is a clear example of the credibility that we have managed to earn, which we appreciate, value and take great care of. It will be our strength from now on.

Looking to the future, we see only work, effort and sacrifice. **Our name shines again among others,** the result of our dedication and love for what we do, but it will not be easy. There is no room to relax and rest; only to stop and contemplate our achievements and get back to work. **We will never sin by omission.**

Finally, I would not like to name names to avoid unjust omissions, but I do want to say that this was not magic. It was the work of a very large group of people who, each from their own place, contributed enormously to **this success that today belongs to and is for ALL HANOAR HATZIONI.**

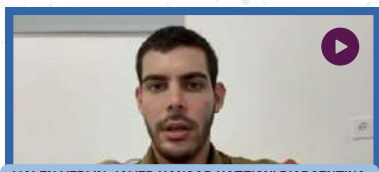

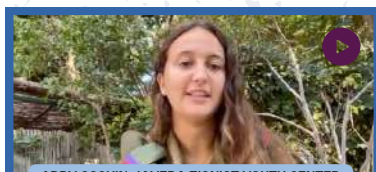
## Volunteering

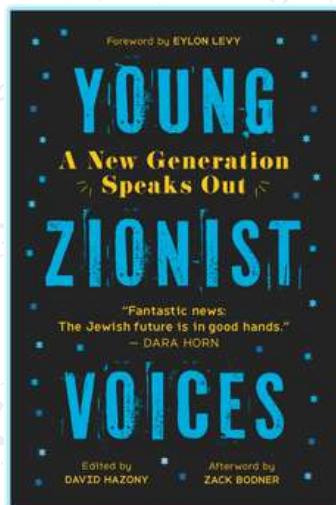

# Mazirut Olamit Activations

- Participated in Ein Hashlosha events, from their stay in Eilat to the National Day of Mourning event on October 7th, where we accompanied and planted a tree on the new path of hope of this kibbutz.
- We carried out activations from MIC 4 to the Nova site.
- We create meaningful initiatives and volunteer work with our Olim and Olot.

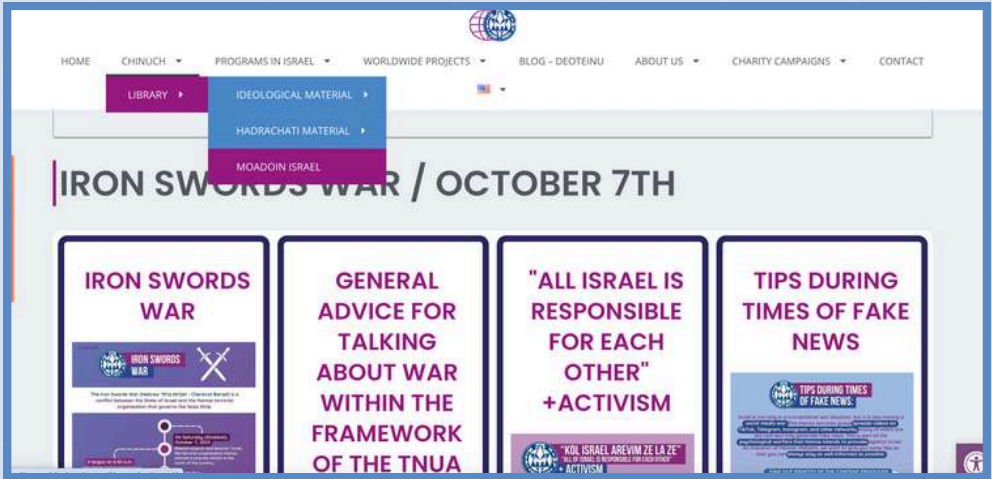
## Testimony kita konenut, October 7th
